



## APPLICATION PROTOCOL INOCULATION FOR VALTO V10

### In general:

- V10 is supplied in liquid form and should be kept at a cool temperature (4-10°C).
- Wear virus-free clothing before you start.
- Disinfect hands and footwear.
- Wear plastic gloves.
- If necessary, wear cotton gloves over plastic gloves.
- Avoid skin contact with the liquid.
- Do not drink the liquid!

### Preparation:

- Shake V10 well.
- Pour 0.8 litre V10 into a large, clean bucket.
- Add 7.2 litres of cold water (4-10°C) to a total of 8 litres.
- Per person: put the sponge supplied with the V10 in the smaller bucket. Sprinkle a bit of an abrasive agent (e.g. synthetic sand) onto the sponge. Pour 500 ml cool, diluted V10 into the bucket. (Ratio: 15 grams of the abrasive agent per litre of water.)
- It is important that the V10 preparation stays cool!



**Application instructions:**

Treat one leaf per stem, just below the head and at middle height, by using one of the following methods:

*Using a scourer*

- Moisten the scourer well and rub the leaf with the rough side, just under the head and at middle height. Rub with one hand and apply counter-pressure with the other hand.
- During application: dip the scouring pad sufficiently in the diluted V10 to ensure that it will remain moist. Repeat this process regularly throughout the application process (e.g. after every 10 plants).

*With your thumb and index finger*

- Wear cotton gloves over plastic gloves.
- Apply by rubbing two square centimetres of the leaf with the preparation: rub your thumb firmly against your index finger, with the leaf in between (you may damage the surface of the leaf, but do not make a hole in it).
- Dip your index finger and thumb regularly into the diluted V10 your thumb and index finger must remain moist. Regularly stir the preparation in the bucket with your fingers (e.g. after treating 10 - 20 plants) to make sure the synthetic sand does not completely sink to the bottom.

**Points for attention:**

- Pay attention to any liquid dripping onto your legs or torso; try to keep the liquid from coming into contact with the skin.
- Undiluted, you can use the virus as long as indicated by the expiration date. Once diluted it should be applied to the plants within a few hours.
